# Pastor's Column

Then Mary said, "Here am I, the servant of the Lord; let it be with me according to your word." [...] "My soul magnifies the Lord, and my spirit rejoices in God my Savior"

Luke 1:38, 46

What a joy it is to join this amazing congregation of God's people — and to do it in the season of Advent! The season of Advent is that time of the church year when we do one thing: we wait. We wait with great anticipation and remembered joy for Christmas, bolstered by our memories of Christmases past and our hopes for Christmas coming soon. We long for the smells and tastes of Christmas back home, we look forward with gleeful anticipation for the joy of children, we rejoice when we turn the radio dial and hear the strains of favorite carols and songs.

As followers of Jesus, Advent-waiting has more depth to it, with stakes greater than gifts under the tree or food on the table or even family gathering together. Advent-waiting is wrapped up in the Good News, the very Best News, possible: Jesus is coming! We hear the stories of Christ coming and celebrate that it happened – and we hear the stories of Christ coming and anticipate how it will happen again.

But in between, we wait.

In our time of waiting, this Advent season, we would do well to consider the person of Mary. Mary is often a prop in our celebration of Advent and Christmas, someone who experiences events without much agency. She's God's servant, Joseph's betrothed, Jesus' mother. Things happen to her, and we think of her as "gentle Mary, meek and mild." There's nothing wrong with those descriptors – but they don't really "fit" Mary. Mary, who chose to accept the angel's word with no fuss, no avoidance, no complaint. Mary, who travelled to her cousin Elizabeth's house and broke out into a revolutionary song of expectation. Mary, who gave birth on her own, far from home, and even in the midst of that painful, joyous, difficult event was able to take in the incredible things happening and ponder them in her heart. Mary, who would be an influence in her son's life right up until the end and who would help the church get going in the first chapter of Acts.

Mary was no shrinking violet; she was an agent of God. And her superpower may well have been her ability to wait – to see what God was doing and to let it develop, to let it grow, to nurture it and protect it and believe in it and then, when the time was at hand, to step forward in faith and release it. Jesus would change the world in all the ways that Mary envisioned in her song in Luke 1 (and in so many more), but she had to wait to see it happen.

Are we looking to God's future with joyful expectation of God's kingdom come? Are we nurturing God's blessing and Christ's power – not to hoard it for ourselves, but to release it into the world? Are we, this Advent, choosing to wait with intention for the coming of Jesus in the daily work of his people – and in the ultimate work of history?

This Advent, let's wait...together.
