A Note from Pastor Adam

The Word became flesh and blood and moved into the neighborhood. – John 1:14 (The Message)

What a Christmas we have had! It was a fun season to enter into life with Farmville Baptist Church and celebrate the coming of Christ with this great congregation. The decorations, the songs, the warm conversations and general air of excitement that the season of Advent and Christmas brings is incredible to experience, and it made me want to celebrate all month long.

Yet, as we get ready to take down the tree and pack away the decorations, as the radio station shelves the Christmas music for another year, we as followers of the child born in Bethlehem would do well to remember something: its not just about Christmas. Or, rather, Christmas isn't a season. The Gospel of John tells us that "the Word became flesh and dwelled among us," or, as Eugene Peterson's paraphrase puts it, "The Word became flesh and blood and moved into the neighborhood."

Maybe it's because my family and I are in the process of moving, but that phrase really stands out to me this year. There is a big difference, you see, between a visit and moving into the neighborhood. When I visit family or friends, it's temporary. Nothing about life really changes; I can overlook their eccentricities, and they can overlook mine. I can ignore their demands or, at worst, grudgingly go along knowing I can escape soon. I smile, I chat, I laugh at their jokes, and then I can leave it behind without any ongoing claim on my life. It was a visit.

But Jesus didn't visit us. He moved in. So we have to wrestle with the implications of that – he came and put down roots in our lives, in our world. And he did it his whole life long: he didn't hold evangelistic crusades, he invested in disciples; he didn't ask people for a one-time donation of time or money, he asked for their whole lives and all they had.


Now, he invites us to do the same. He doesn't invite us to hole up in a bastion of Christian refuge and only make occasional sorties into the world "out there" with token expressions of love and grace and good news. He invites us to move into the

neighborhood – to do the hard work of connecting with people and investing in their lives the way Jesus invested in our lives, to walk with them through good times and bad, to be the tangible expression of God's presence in an ongoing way.

Howard Thurman, a pastor and teacher of the way of the Spirit, captures well what this looks like in his book, *The Mood of Christmas*. May his wise words inspire us as we step into a new year, together, as the people of God living in the incarnate, neighborly way of Jesus.


