



"...what was now being referred to as 'the Way." Acts 19:23b (The Message)

There is this rather unusual thing that happens in the book of Acts: while the early Jesus movement is gathering and beginning to grow and spread, there is confusion over what the people who are part of that movement are called. Sometimes, they are called the church. Other times, they are called Jews, or a sect of Jews. Often, they are considered troublemakers and rabble-rousers. Eventually, in Antioch, they are called Christians, or 'little Christs.' But from fairly early on, all the way through to near the end of Acts, there are folks who call those who are part of the early church 'followers of the Way,' and the early church movement itself as 'the Way.'

It's interesting to note that, of the six explicit references to the early church as 'the Way' in the book of Acts, at least five of them (and maybe all six) are coming from the perspective of an outsider. Those outside the fellowship of Jesus people didn't know (or particularly care about) the specific beliefs of those who gathered in the name of Jesus or the ways they differed from other Jews or Gentiles. They simply knew what they saw – the way of life these groups of people lived together. And by those practices, those general ways of living, these early churches were known.

That's why, during the Easter season in worship, we are getting little snapshots of the Way.

You may have noticed that in our worship service, we usually have two Scripture readings: a sermon text that I (or whoever is preaching) explore, and a second, earlier text that gets our minds focused along certain trains of thought and enhances our worship of God. But for the six Sundays between Easter and Pentecost, during the portion of the service where we consider what our calling is as a church to respond to God's grace and vision of the world, we are also getting a snapshot of the Way, a glimpse into how the early church lived out its new identity as the people of God in Jesus Christ.

In these snapshots, we see the early church gathering together and sharing meals. We see them listening to the teachings of the apostles – those who had been with Jesus – and learning more about what the resurrection life and God's kingdom mean, here and now. We see them caring for the poor and serving the sick. We see them bringing their resources together – money, food, time, effort – to help the needy and serve the church and community. We see the church doing the things Jesus did.

I don't know about you, but I hope these snapshots of 'the Way' help me to be a more faithful follower of Jesus, so that those around me can see the things I do and notice that they are the sorts of things Jesus did. I am grateful to be part of a church that wants the same thing. I pray a snapshot of Farmville Baptist Church will look something like those early snapshots of the Way.





FBC is blessed to have Adam, and his family, as a part of our church family. We look forward to the journey and future of FBC!





















New Discipleship Opportunity! Spring/Summer 2022
