

### **The Life-Changing Moment**

So if anyone is in Christ, there is a new creation: everything old has passed away; see, everything has become new!

2 Corinthians 5:17

March is a special time for our family, a time to celebrate when new things, new life, happened. The month of March is when Cadance celebrates her birthday and when the two of us were married. It is also the month when Jonathan, our firstborn, entered the world. All three of those special occasions were incredibly important. Though Cadance's birthday wouldn't affect me until long after it happened, it and the other two moments, with more immediate effects, would alter the trajectory of my life and the life of our family.

All of us have moments like that in our lives: birthdays, graduations, anniversaries, retirements, doctor's visits, funerals. Whether good or bad, or some mix of the two, life after that event can never be the same. Someone new has entered our life, some identity that we hold is altered, something important that matters to us has been added or lost. To pretend after that moment that life is the same as before is problematic; to embrace the new reality, whether joyful or sorrowful, is the most honest, and most full, response to living that we can choose.

If we are following Jesus, there is another moment that can and should fundamentally affect our lives. We celebrate and remember it next month: the death and resurrection of Jesus Christ. First comes the crucifixion. The death of Jesus on the cross has many implications and interpretations: righting the scales of sin, rescuing humanity from evil, challenging the powers of the world and triumphing over them by sacrificial love, and more. The cross has been the symbol of the Christian movement almost from the start, because the cross is central to the work of Jesus in all its rich meaning.

Then, the empty tomb. The resurrection of Jesus Christ is the turning point of human history. In the resurrection, God triumphs over sin and death. Through the resurrection, the new life of God's kingdom reality begins to take root in our world. Because of the resurrection, the world has hope, and so do we, that what God did for Jesus he will do for us. The resurrection is at the core of the Gospel, the center of God's story.

This intertwined moment, then, of the crucifixion and the resurrection, is one of those life-changing moments for followers of Jesus. Even though it happened millennia before any of us now living were born, the effects of those moments are still being transformational in our lives today...or, at least, they should be. If our lives are no different than they were before we began following Jesus, or if they are indistinguishable from others who don't follow Jesus, then we may rightly question if we are letting those monumental events change us. But if we can look at our lives, and there is fruit, tangible evidence – some internal, some external – that we live differently because of the cross and the empty tomb, then we have let the life and person of Jesus affect us. We have begun living into our new identity in Christ.

Have we embraced the life-changing moment of the death and resurrection of Jesus?







The Jesus I Never Knew invites us to return to the stories of Jesus we find in the Gospels and encounter him anew.


